

Strategic Advice

- Strategic Servicing Plan – Assisted one of Australia’s largest water and sewerage service providers to develop a strategic servicing plan to identify key servicing and investment needs over the next 30 years. The strategic plan included developing an integrated planning and servicing strategy to meet environmental, social and economic planning targets. The service provider is expecting an increase in its customer base of over one million people placing pressure on its existing infrastructure and driving an unprecedented capital investment program.
